Offices reopening to public on July 20

The Nunatsiavut Government wishes to advise that effective Monday, July 20, all of its offices will open to the general public for the first time since March 18, after being closed amid concerns over potential exposure to and spread of the coronavirus COVID-19.

Those planning on visiting any Nunatsiavut Government office are still being encouraged to call ahead beforehand and schedule an appointment, where possible.

As well, members of the public will not be permitted to use or enter the kitchens, washrooms or to walk through any Nunatsiavut Government building to access staff, but rather be required to remain in reception areas until escorted to an office or meeting room.

While the risk of infection to COVID-19 remains low, individuals are reminded to ensure they follow generally-accepted health protocols to minimize potential exposure and spread of the virus when visiting any Nunatsiavut Government office or facility.
