Through Nunatsiavut Government's Aboriginal Skills & Employment Training Strategy (ASETS), Inuit Pathways offers financial assistance to Organizations/employers to hire students for summer work opportunities. The program is designed to provide meaningful summer work experience to students. This summer work will assist students to develop career focus, as well as, enhance employability skills.

Eligibility Criteria

Summer students must be a beneficiary of the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement

Summer students must be at least 15 but under 30 years of age at beginning of summer work project

Students participating in summer work activities must have been previously enrolled in secondary or post-secondary education and be returning to school upon completion of summer work project.

Interested employers must complete a Summer Work Program Application
