REGULATIONS AUTHORIZING THE REGISTRAR OF NUNATSIAVUT LAWS TO MAKE ELECTRONIC VERSIONS OF NUNATSIAVUT LAWS AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC

The President of the Nunatsiavut Government is pleased to enact the following Regulations with the advice of the Nunatsiavut Executive Council:

Short Title

1.

These Regulations may be cited as the Electronic Publication of Laws Regulations.

Authority

2.

These Regulations are made under sections 32 and 44 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act.*

Interpretation

3.

Terms used in these Regulations have the same meaning as in the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act*.

Enactments to be made available to the Public

4.

For the purpose of section 32 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act*, the Registrar shall make the following electronic versions of Enactments available to the public on the Internet:

(a) Inuit Laws arranged chronologically by year;

- (b) Subordinate Legislation arranged chronologically by year;
- (c) the continuing consolidation of Inuit Laws arranged alphabetically;
- (d) the continuing consolidation of Subordinate Legislation arranged alphabetically; and
- (e) ByLaws arranged chronologically by Inuit Community.

Format of public electronic versions of Enactments

5.

The public electronic versions of the Enactments referred to in section 4 of these Regulations shall be made available for download in PDF format .

Additional information about Enactments

6.

The Registrar may make available such other information about the Enactments referred to in section 4 of these Regulations as he/she considers necessary or advisable including, without limitation, information respecting the citation of Enactments, their currency (or respective effective or repeal dates), amendments to Enactments, and lists of Enactments excluded from consolidations.

Links to other information

7.

The Registrar may also make available on the Nunatsiavut Assembly page links to such other legislation and information as he/she considers appropriate but all links external to the Nunatsiavut Government must contain a disclaimer making clear that the Nunatsiavut Government is not responsible for their content.
