# AN INUIT LAW TO AMEND THE STANDING ORDERS AND PROCEDURES OF THE NUNATSIAVUT ASSEMBLY

WHEREAS, the Members of the Nunatsiavut Assembly wish to extend the time and number of questions allocated to Members as set out in the *Standing Orders and Procedure for the Nunatsiavut Legislative Assembly* attached as Schedule A to the *Nunatsiavut Assembly Act*, IL 2005-09.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly as follows:

### 1. Standing Order number 56 is amended so as to provide:

A period of no more than 60 minutes shall be set aside at the beginning of each sitting of the Assembly for Members to ask questions of other Members or Ministers.

### 2. Standing Order number 58 is amended so as to provide:

Generally a Member will be permitted to ask two questions per day.

## 3. Standing Order number 59 is amended so as to provide:

At the discretion of the Speaker, a Member may ask no more than two supplemental questions per question, provided that the questions are clearly supplemental to the original question and not on a different topic.
