### EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE MINISTER OF LANDS AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO TRANSFER ADMINISTRATION AND CONTROL OF AN AREA OF LABRADOR INUIT LANDS AT VILLAGE BAY TO ANOTHER MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources of the Nunatsiavut Government considers it appropriate to transfer of the administration and control of a certain portion of Labrador Inuit Lands to the Minister of Language Culture and Tourism of the Nunatsiavut Government;

**AND WHEREAS** section 2.3 *Labrador Inuit Lands Act* requires that the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources obtain the written consent of the Executive Council to such a transfer;

**AND WHEREAS** the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources has assured the Executive Council that the transfer will be carried out in accordance with the requirements of section 2.4 of the *Labrador Inuit Lands Act*;

**NOW THEREFORE** The President of Nunatsiavut, acting with the consent and advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to **ORDER** that:

### **Authority**

1

This Executive Order is made under section 2.3 of the Labrador Inuit Lands Act.

### Interpretation

2

Unless the context otherwise requires, terms used in this Executive Order have the same meaning as in the Labrador Inuit Lands Act.

### **Approval of Transfer**

The Executive Counsel herby consents to the transfer of administration and control of the following portion of Labrador Inuit Lands from the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources to the Minister of Language Culture and Tourism, which hereinafter is referred to as the "Lot":

All of that portion of Labrador Inuit Lands depicted in the attached Certificate of Land Transfer as application No. A2019\_004, located at Village Bay.

The transfer of administration and control of the Lot described herein in no way affects the continuing status of the Lot as Labrador Inuit Lands and the *Labrador Inuit Lands Act* shall continue to apply to the lot including, without restricting the generality of the forgoing, section 2.5 of that Act.
