REGULATION RESPECTING OATHS OF OFFICE OF ANGAJUKAK AND COUNCILLOR OF AN INUIT COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT

The First Minister of Nunatsiavut is pleased to enact the following regulations:

Short Title

1.

These regulations may be cited as the *Inuit Community Government Elected Officials Oaths of Office Regulations*, 2006.

Authority

2.

These regulations are made under subsection 141(3) of the Nunatsiavut Elections Act.

Interpretation

3.

Unless the context otherwise requires, terms used in these regulations have the same meaning as in the *Nunatsianut Elections Act*.

Oath or Affirmation of Office of Angajukak

4.

For purposes of subsection 147(3) of the *Nunatsiavut Elections Act* the required oath or affirmation for the Angajukak of an Inuit Community is set out in Schedule A.

Oath Affirmation of Office of Councillor

5.

For purposes of subsection 147(4) of the *Nunatsiavut Elections Act* the required oath or affirmation for a Councillor of an Inuit Community Council is set out in Schedule B.
