President sends condolences to families of victims of mass stabbings in Saskatchewan

Nunatsiavut President Johannes Lampe today issued the following statement on the mass stabbings resulting in 10 people being killed and 18 injured on the James Smith Cree Nation and in the nearby community of Welton, Saskatchewan on September 4:

“On behalf of the Nunatsiavut Government and Beneficiaries of the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement, I would like to express my deepest and sincerest condolences to the families and loved ones of the victims of this terrible tragedy. One can only imagine the heartache and sadness that come from such a horrific event.

“We also wish a full and quick recovery to those who were injured. Our thoughts are with them all and their families, and community, during this very difficult and trying time.”
