



IMPORTANT INFORMATION--Program Description and Eligibility

The Nunatsiavut Housing Commission is now accepting applications for the 2023/2024 Furnace and Oil Tank Repair Program from Beneficiaries of the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement residing in the Inuit Communities of Makkovik and Rigolet. Due to limited funding, not all Beneficiaries will be able to receive support from this program. To receive support, you must:

- a) Meet the eligibility criteria set out in the Nunatsiavut Housing Commission Home Repair Program Policy. The basic eligibility is as follows:
 - a. Must meet the definition of Beneficiary as defined under Part 1.1 under the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement;
 - b. Reside in Rigolet or Makkovik;
 - c. Meet residency requirements;
 - d. Must be the owner of the home, or provide proof of consent from the homeowner for the repairs, if renting, and;
 - e. Must not have received assistance from the Nunatsiavut Government to repair or replace furnace or oil tank in the last five years.
- b) Complete this Application Form; and
- c) Submit a copy of the 2022 Notice of Assessment(s) from Canada Revenue Agency for all permanent residents of the household between the ages of 18-65.
