

**ORDER RESPECTING THE APPOINTMENT OF COUNCILLORS TO THE INUIT COMMUNITY COUNCIL OF RIGOLET (2023).**

**WHEREAS** nominations were called for the election of councillors to the Inuit Community Council of Rigolet from May 23-29, 2023 and August 14-21, 2023 but fewer candidates were nominated than there were councillors to be elected;

**AND WHEREAS** as a result there are vacant seats on the Inuit Community Council of Rigolet;

**AND WHEREAS** the *Inuit Community Government Elections Act* gives the First Minister the authority to make appointments to fill vacancies on Inuit Community Councils if vacancies remain after repeated elections;

**AND WHEREAS** the Inuit Community Council of Rigolet has asked the First Minister to consider appointing councillors to fill the vacant seats;

**NOW THEREFORE** the First Minister is pleased to **ORDER** that:

**Short Title**

1

This Order may be cited as the *Rigolet Councillors Appointment Order, 2023*.

**Authority**

This Order is made under sections 13(2) of the *Inuit Community Government Elections Act*.

**Interpretation**

Unless the context otherwise requires, terms used in this Order have the same meaning as in the *Inuit Community Government Elections Act*.

## Appointments

4

- (1) The following individuals are appointed to hold office as councillors to represent Inuit Residents and their Descendants (also known as the 'A Voters Roll') on the Inuit Community Council for the Inuit Community of Rigolet:
  - (a) Georgina Allen, of Rigolet
  - (b) Elsie Wolfrey, of Rigolet.
- (2) The term of office of the individuals appointed under subsection 1 is the term set out in section 32(2) of the *Inuit Community Government Elections Act*.
