The Nunatsiavut Government and Parks Canada are working together to assess the feasibility of establishing the Torngat Area of Interest as an Inuit Protected Area under the *Canada National Marine Conservation Areas Act*.

Community engagements are being held in Nunavik and Nunatsiavut to discuss the feasibility assessment process, where the Steering Committee will share highlights from the "What We Heard Report".
