Responsibilities:

- Ability to lead on the ground, oversee three staff (Hebron Ambassador, Bear Guard and Hebron Laborer) and work independently.
- Provide tours of the Church and of the Inuit and German graveyard.
- Keep a written record of visitations to Hebron.
- Participate in a briefing and debriefing before and after the season.
- Provide a detailed summary of the season including what visitors were interested in and any recommendations for the upcoming season.
- Be mindful of archaeological features, graveyard and other culturally sensitive materials and ensure none are disturbed.
- Ensure safety of yourself and visitors.
- Ensuring all employees are fulfilling their duties, that staff are safe at all times.
- Participate in a briefing and debriefing at the beginning and end of the season with Division of Tourism Staff.
- Participate in any identified training.
- Other related duties as required.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma.
- 3 years' experience in a supervisor position.
- Knowledge about the history of Hebron, surrounding area and Labrador Inuit.
- Ability to provide guided tours of the Hebron Church and graveyard.
- Ability to communicate effectively with persons of a wide variety of backgrounds and skills, including: community members, researchers, government agencies, internal staff, external working groups and others.
- Be aware of surroundings and able to work in a remote environment.
- Ability to work independently.
- Ability to lead employees and handle any unexpected situations that arise from working in a remote area.
- Ability to work in a remote and isolated location.
