Question 1:

If we are audiologists licensed with colleges in other Canadian Provinces (NB, NS, ON), would we be able to include the cost of obtaining a college license for audiology in NFLD as part of the proposal?

Answer:

The Audiologist responding to the Request for Proposals will be responsible for obtaining a college license for audiology in NL, the Nunatsiavut Government will take no responsibility.

Question 2:

To understand the length of time for a visit, it would be helpful to understand more about population numbers that would be relevant in each location for audiology services.

Answer:

Question 3:

Understanding that these areas are very remote, how would audiologists travel between locations. Would it be by small airplane, pilot provided? I noticed it says car if available.

Answer:

The five Nunatsiavut communities are remote and only accessible by boat (in the summer months) or twin otter. The successful audiologist would travel between communities by twin otter.

Question 4:

Have audiology services been provided before in these locations?

Answer:

No, Audiology services have not been provided directly within the five Nunatsiavut communities.
