2024 Residential Application

The Nunatsiavut Energy Efficiency Retrofit (NEER) Program is now accepting applications for homeowners interested in energy efficiency improvements.

This program is available to Beneficiaries in the Labrador Inuit Settlement Area who meet the requirements of the program and reside in the Inuit Communities of Nain, Hopedale, Postville, Makkovik, and Rigolet. Only the owner of the home can complete this application; if you do not own your home, you are not eligible to participate in this program at this time.

The goal of this program is to reduce greenhouse gas emissions on a community-wide scale while improving air quality and home comfort for residents of Nunatsiavut. This can be done by upgrading existing building systems to reduce the amount of electricity used and improving the insulation of homes. We have grants of up to \$20,000 available for eligible home efficiency upgrades for all types of home heating.

Approved applicants will receive a free home energy audit to measure how much energy is consumed in your home. Energy audits are done by trained professionals and are used to determine areas where your home's systems are underperforming or can be improved upon. Based on feedback from your energy audit, you could qualify for upgrades such as insulation, heating system upgrades, thermostats and other measures.

Applications for this program will be accepted from May 8th to July 10, 2024. More information on program details, what to expect throughout the process and eligibility criteria can be found in the **NEER Program Guidelines** document.

Energy audits will be undertaken in the summer and fall of 2024. Installation contractors will be available in 2025 to complete upgrades identified in homes approved for financial contributions from NG.
