Mr. Speaker, the Finance Division undertook a detailed analysis of meal allowances. New rates were approved, effective mid-July, as well as special meal allowances for international travel. These rates are outlined on Atukatigevik for employees and Elected Officials.

There are number of key projects on-going within the Finance Division. There is a significant upgrade being completed in the financial management system, one that will allow electronic timekeeping and purchasing functions. The plan is electronic purchasing by mid-November and timesheets in January 2026.

This upgrade is being completed with professional services assistance from Vision33 and Criterion. Finance continues to make progress on the audits of the financial statements, financial reporting to Indigenous Services Canada, compliance audits with external funders, budget management, all while completing their daily financial tasks.

Mr. Speaker, Woodward's Oil has informed the Nunatsiavut Government that as of January 1st, they will no longer accept purchase orders and invoice for payment. Credit or debit cards, fleet cards or cash will be the only methods of payments accepted. Employees within the Finance division are under reviewing the business processes to ensure that the impact of this change is minimal to program and service delivery, while ensuring financial controls are in place.
