

Addendum #1 Request for Proposals Establishing an Online Voting Option for the Canadian Constituency of the Nunatsiavut Assembly

All prospective proponents are hereby advised of the following questions and answers:

Questions:

- How many voters will be eligible to participate? Is there a set list of voters available?
- How often annually will voting be conducted?
- Could you provide more detail regarding the database management element of the RFP?
- How do you envision the compiling and expanding email registry functioning?
- Regarding the legislative reform element- will the response to the RFP function in this capacity, or is additional vendor side activity required? If so, what is the expectation?
- We noted that any certifications required for the provinces of Newfoundland and Labrador should be listed- are there any specifics required that you are aware of?

Answers:

- Approximately 2500 Beneficiaries live in the constituency of Canada and the list is maintained by the Registrar of Beneficiaries.
- At least once every two years: Presidential and General Elections are staggered and happen every four years. However, there is also the possibility of byelections outside of this schedule.
- This element is up to the proponent to determine.
- The legislation will be created and passed by the Nunatsiavut Assembly and may or may not be impacted by the exact specifications by the successful proponent.

• There are none required, but if any member(s) of the proponent has accreditations or certifications they should describe them.

Deadline for proposals has been extended to 4:00PM Labrador Time on December 8th, 2025.
