## Response to Enquiries

The Nunatsiavut Government received the following enquiries from prospective proponents, to which the following answers are provided to the public:

## Objective 5:

**Design a data system that enables the NG to manage research data and Inuit traditional knowledge** – in a way that preserves cultural integrity, recognizes ownership and property rights, and supports fair and transparent collaboration between NG, Inuit communities, and external partners.

## Question: What do we mean when we say “Design a Data System”?

**Answer:** In this RFP, the phrase “**Design a Data System**” refers to the **development of policies, procedures, and recommended approaches** for managing data in a manner that upholds Inuit Data Sovereignty, reflects Inuit values, and enables transparent collaboration among NG, Inuit

communities, and external partners. The design or development of a new technical data system is **outside the scope of this RFP**, but is anticipated as the **ultimate long-term goal**.
