Mr. Speaker, the Nunatsiavut Government has engaged Firelight Inc. to catalogue all existing policies, protocols and practices within the Department of Health and Social Development related to health and social data, identify gaps related to privacy, consent, documentation, confidentiality, digital access controls, to name a few areas and provide recommendations for policy development.

In February, the Information Technology division organized a three day, in-person workshop, co-facilitated by Firelight Inc. This workshop had approximately 25 participants from the Department of Health and Social Development.
