Apply to the Nunatsiavut Energy Efficiency Retrofit (NEER) program

2026 Residential Application

The Nunatsiavut Energy Efficiency Retrofit (NEER) Program is now accepting applications for homeowners interested in making energy efficiency improvements. This program is available to Beneficiaries in the Labrador Inuit Settlement Area who meet the program requirements and reside in the Inuit Communities of Nain, Hopedale, Postville, Makkovik, and Rigolet. Only the homeowner can complete this application; if you do not own your home, you are not eligible for this program at this time.

The goal of this program is to reduce greenhouse gas emissions on a community-wide scale while also improving indoor air quality and home comfort for residents of Nunatsiavut. This can be done by upgrading existing building systems to reduce the amount of energy used and improving the insulation of homes. Eligible homeowners may qualify for **grants of up to \$20,000** (based on household income) to support home efficiency upgrades. This applies to homes with all types of heating systems.

Approved applicants will receive a **free home energy assessment conducted** by trained professionals. This assessment will determine how much energy your home consumes and identify where improvements can be made. Based on the results, you may qualify for upgrades such as heating system upgrades, insulation upgrades, and other energy efficiency measures.

Applications for this program will be accepted from **June 22nd to August 31st, 2026**.

Energy assessments are expected to take place during the summer and fall following application approval. Installation contractors are anticipated to complete approved upgrades in 2027.

To support program evaluation, quality assurance, and measurement of energy savings, Nunatsiavut Government and CLEAResult request permission to access your electricity consumption data from Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (NL Hydro). Your NL Hydro account number and electricity consumption data will be used to support administration of the NEER Program, verify eligibility, assess energy savings and program outcomes, and coordinate with other applicable energy efficiency programs.

NOA submission must be received **no later than August 31st, 2026**. Applications without the required Notice(s) of Assessment by the deadline may be deemed incomplete and may not be eligible for program funding. This information is only collected to determine program eligibility and financial contribution amounts from NG.

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Submission of an application does not guarantee approval or funding. Financial contributions are subject to program eligibility, available funding, and completion of the energy assessment process.
