REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

CONSTRUCTION OF BOARDROOM TABLE - MAKKOVIK

The Nunatsiavut Government is requesting proposals from individuals or business who may be interested in constructing a circular boardroom table for the Education Division building in Makkovik.

The table must be constructed in multiple pieces to be transported into the permanent location and assembled on site. Table will be housed in the Education Division boardroom that is circular and 45 sq. meters with built-in seating around part of the perimeter. Table must have a circular design with a diameter of 9'6" to 10' to be able to comfortably accommodate 16 standard office chairs. Tabletop should be solid wood or wood & resin combination and include a minimum of two built-in units with power outlets. The base of the table must be pedestal-style.

Those who wish to make a proposal are expected to provide to the Nunatsiavut Government:

- A design of the table that they propose to construct which outlines the materials, dimensions, and assembly requirements;
- A detailed timeline for design, production and delivery; and
- The total cost, including materials, labour and shipping.
